Develop Craft

- Learning to use and care for tools and materials.
- Practicing and developing skills and techniques.

Engage & Persist

Grabbing hold of an idea and sticking with it.

Envision

Using imagination, innovation, or invention.

Express

Learning to create works that communicate an idea, feeling or personal meaning.

Observe

Learning to look closely or in a new way to see things that others may not.

Reflect

- Learning to think and talk about your work and the work of others.
- Learning to judge your own work and the work of others.
- Examining your own creative process.

Stretch & Explore

Reaching, taking creative risks, exploring, playing with ideas/materials/techniques and DISCOVERING.

Understanding the Art World

- Learn about art history and current practice.
- Learning to work as artists in a community of artists.

Make sure your project demonstrates:

1. Effort
2. Craftsmanship
3. Creativity

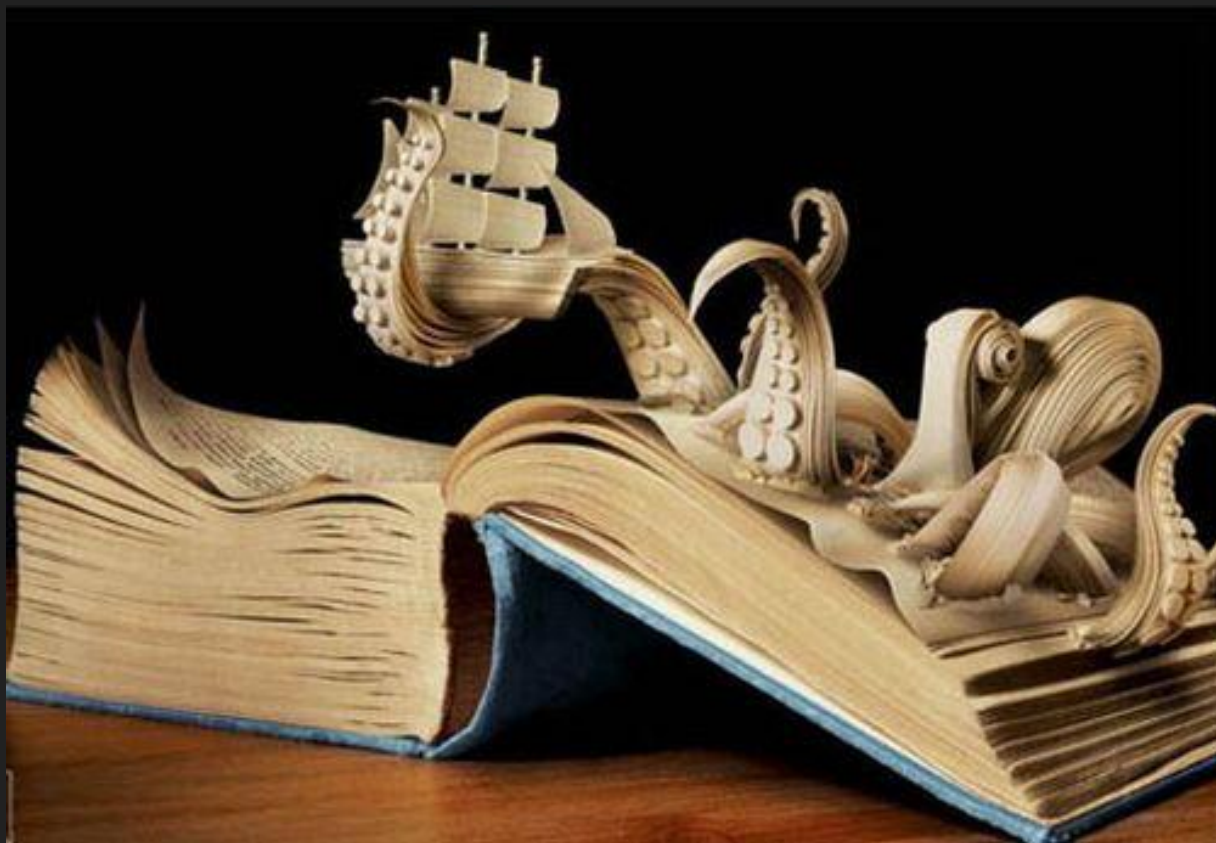
